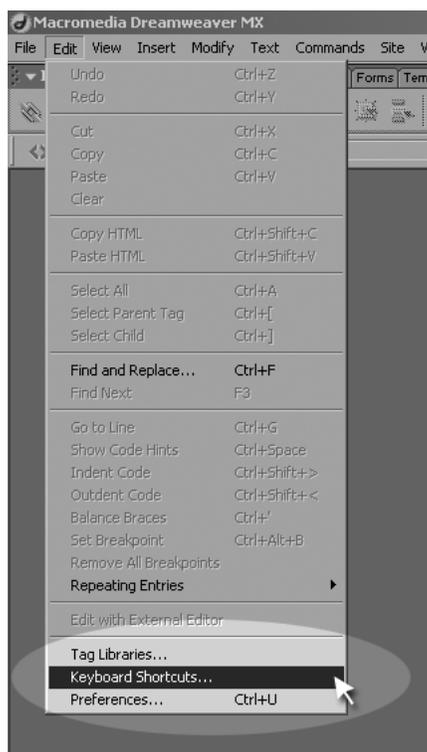


Setting up Keyboard Shortcuts in Dreamweaver MX



The following tutorial is taken from instructions for setting up the X-keys Professional Keyboard for Dreamweaver MX. Programming the keyboard shortcuts into an X-keys gives you a single, custom key for these functions.



We use the "Code View" command for this tutorial, but any command in Dreamweaver's menu may be used following the same steps.

► Step 1 - Open the Edit Menu and Select "Keyboard Shortcuts"

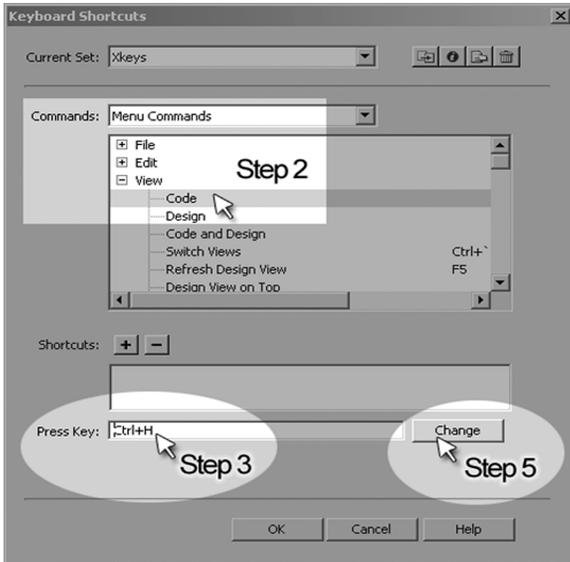
The "Keyboard Shortcuts" window will open and display your current settings.

If you have not created a new keyboard shortcut before, clicking on the "Change" button will prompt the following message:

"The current factory set cannot be modified. To create a modifiable set, click OK to duplicate the current set"

Click OK and give your new set a name.

If you have already created a custom set of keyboard shortcuts, just add the following changes.



► **Step 2 - In the Commands Window, select "View" and "Code"**

► **Step 3 - Click in the "Press Key" Field**

► **Step 4 - Enter the shortcut key combination**

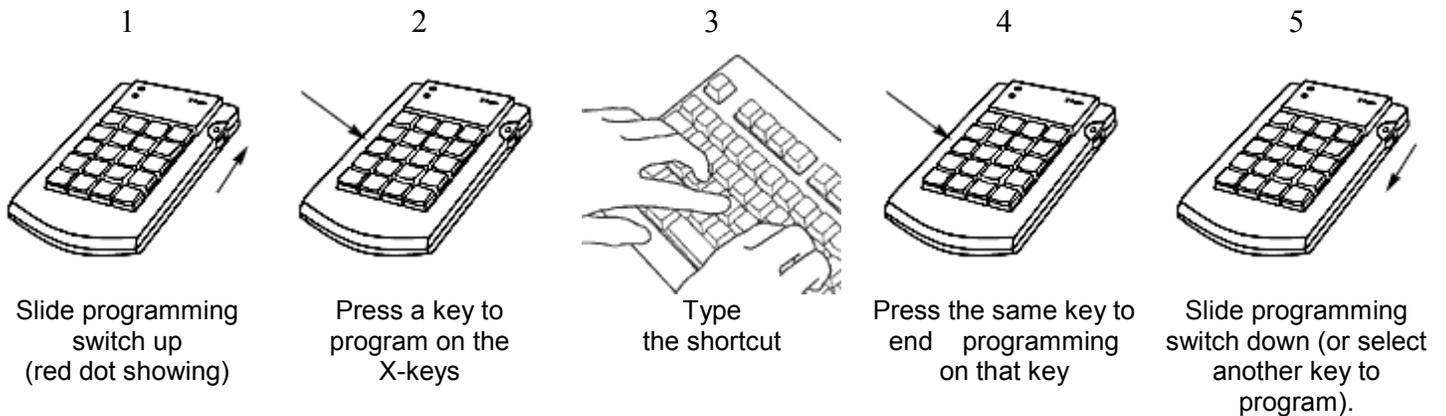
► **Step 5 - Click the "Change" Button**

The shortcut will appear in the shortcuts window and to the right of "Code" in the command window.

► **Step 6 - Click OK to save your new settings**

You may follow the same steps in this tutorial to create keyboard shortcuts for any menu item in Dreamweaver MX and then program the shortcut into any key on your X-keys. We recommend creating the keyboard shortcut in Dreamweaver MX first to avoid conflicts with existing keyboard shortcuts.
